1. Visit HSRProj at [www.nlm.nih.gov/hsrproj](http://www.nlm.nih.gov/hsrproj)
2. Search by topics, funders, researchers, location and more, using basic or advanced search features.
3. Review project information including abstracts, start and end dates, funding information, principal investigators and performing organizations.
4. Download the entire HSRProj database to do detailed analyses on trends.
5. Enhance your skills and learn more about how to leverage HSRProj through webinars, short online courses and cases studies of research conducted using HSRProj at [academyhealth.org/HSRProjTraining](http://academyhealth.org/HSRProjTraining).
